JG Thirlwell and Fred Bigot release collaborative vinyl EP



French art/music label [Optical Sound](#) has released the long-awaited duo project of [JG Thirlwell](#) and [Fred Bigot](#), named [Hydroze Plus](#). Thirlwell, better known as [Foetus](#), is a producer, remixer, and performer whose work spans 25 years and who is soundtrack composer for *The Venture Brothers* on Cartoon Network.

Though Thirlwell has written for instruments of all varieties, here his contributions consist of vocals and lyrics. Bigot, also known as [Electronicat](#), is credited here for instruments and music.

The EP is clear, ten-inch vinyl with packaging designed by Thirlwell. The EP's several transparent layers were made to look like an anatomical text book. It's a limited release only available through Optical Sound, though it will soon be available digitally through Ectopic Ents.
